



# Christian Congregational Scholarship - Information

Christian Congregational Scholarships are offered in conjunction with the School's foundational values of Christian practice and purpose. Applicants are required to be in regular attendance at a Christian Church and to have a developing understanding of the Christian Faith. In addition, it is a requirement that one parent be actively involved in a Christian Church, including participation in worship and additional Church activities.

## Christian Congregational scholarships are available to students entering St Paul's in 2020 (in any year group above Year 3)

- Available to those who are **NOT** currently enrolled at St Paul's.
- Scholarships vary in value and duration, subject to satisfactory performance.

## Who can apply? Students entering St Paul's in 2020 and are:

- Prospective students who have applied to St Paul's for enrolment in 2020 in any year group above Year 3
- Family Christian Congregational Scholarships are available.

## How to apply:

Applicants not currently enrolled must complete an Enrolment Application. This should be forwarded to the school prior to the closing date. All Applications must be submitted in hard copy by post or in person to the Director of Enrolments and Public Relations in the Secondary School Administration Office. You will receive an email confirmation of application receipt after the closing date. Emailed Scholarship Applications will not be accepted.

Students can apply for multiple scholarship categories.
