Performing Arts Scholarship recipients are not required to undertake private tuition at the School, although full facilities are available. However, it is expected that successful candidates will be receiving appropriate Performing Arts tuition either within or external to the School.

Applicants will not automatically be auditioned – the panel will short-list those to be invited to progress to audition.

Students who receive a Performing Arts Scholarship are expected to contribute fully to the performance life of the School. Performing Arts Scholarships recipients are expected to choose Music, Dance, or Drama (whichever is appropriate) as an elective subject in Years 9 to 12 and to participate in ongoing activities such as school orchestra, school band or school choir, drama groups and dance ensembles. They will be expected to contribute to special occasion performances. Should the student decide to discontinue his or her performance pursuits at St Paul's for any reason, other than injury or a reason approved by the Principal, the continuation of the Scholarship would be reviewed by the School.
