Applications for Performing Arts Scholarships

Applications for Scholarships are accepted for students who are currently enrolled at St Paul’s Grammar School or who have applied for enrolment.

All Applications must be submitted in **hard copy** by post or in person to the Director of Enrolments and Public Relations in the Secondary School Administration Office. You will receive confirmation of application receipt after the closing date. **Emailed Scholarship Applications are not accepted.**

Please provide a Portfolio that gives details of the student’s Performing Arts ability and experience. The portfolio provides the basis upon which you would like to see this application evaluated. Please include copies of documentary evidence and the two most recent school reports in the Portfolio. Please provide copies of supporting documentation, not originals, as documentation will not be returned.

If a student has not applied to be enrolled at St Paul’s Grammar School, an **Application for Enrolment Form** and a **Portfolio of Achievement** must accompany this **Application for Scholarship**

Applicants will not automatically be auditioned – the panel will short-list those to be invited to progress to audition.

Closing date for Scholarship Applications: Tuesday, 1st March 2022.

Performing Arts Tuition and School Expectations

Performing Arts Scholarship recipients are not required to undertake private tuition at the School, although full facilities are available. However, it is expected that successful candidates will be receiving appropriate Performing Arts tuition either within or external to the School.

Students who receive a Performing Arts Scholarship are expected to contribute fully to the performance life of the School. Performing Arts Scholarships recipients are encouraged to choose Music, Dance, or Drama (whichever is appropriate) as an elective subject in Years 9 to 12 and are expected to participate in ongoing activities such as school orchestra, school band or school choir, drama groups and dance ensembles. They will be expected to contribute to special occasion performances. Should the student decide to discontinue his or her performance pursuits at St Paul’s for any reason, other than injury or a reason approved by the Principal, the continuation of the Scholarship would be reviewed by the School.
