Schedule of Fees and Charges

Application and Enrolment

Application Fee \$150 per student

This must accompany each new student application. The fee is not refundable and is inclusive of GST.

Enrolment Fee \$1,000 per student

The Enrolment Fee confirms acceptance of the place offered and is **non-refundable**.

This Enrolment Fee replaces the refundable Enrolment Deposit that applied in 2019 and previous years. Tuition Fees and Levies

Tuition Fees and Levies are payable at the commencement of each school term, as per the terms and conditions of enrolment, unless participating in an instalment Payment Plan agreed in writing with the school. Prior to each term, the school will email notification of the Fee Statements. Additional copies of statements can be provided upon request.

Year 12 fees are invoiced over three terms.

Levies are intended to include the majority of compulsory charges that apply to all students in each year group for camps, excursions, incursions, swimming and athletics carnivals together with elective subject fees and various other services and resources provided by the school.

Other costs relating to elective subjects or optional activities may become payable during the year. The fees for these will be advised prior to permission for, or commencement of, the activity.

Sibling Concession

A Tuition Fee sibling concession is allowable where two or more members of the immediate family concurrently attend the school between the grades of Kindergarten to Year 12. The sibling concession does not extend to Levies or other charges, nor does it apply to Pre-Kindergarten tuition.

Sibling concessions are:

- 15% second child
- 22.5% third child
- 75% fourth and subsequent children

General Information

Withdrawal

Written notice of the withdrawal of a student must be given to the Principal one full term in advance. In default of such notice, an additional **term's fees are payable in lieu**.

Additional Charges

Additional charges may arise for concerts, events and optional excursions that become available during the year. These charges will be payable in full prior to the event.

Other costs including textbooks, uniforms and stationery are purchased separately by each family.

Payment Options

Single Annual Payment

One annual payment made by Friday of the first week of Term 1. This option receives a 2.5% discount of the Net Tuition Fees if the amount is paid in full on or before the due date.

- The discount does not apply to Levies.
- The discount will be applied after any discounts or concessions, including scholarships, are applied to the family account.
- The discount is not applicable for Pre-K fees because we receive no government funding for this service. The discount is only applicable to Tuition Fees for students in Kindergarten to Year 12.

Periodic Payment Plan

In January every year, a direct debit Payment Plan is provided to families that allows payments to occur from February to November on a weekly, fortnightly or monthly basis.

Non-Payment of Fees

If payment of fees is not received by the statement due date (unless a periodic Payment Plan was chosen), a late fee of \$100 will be incurred.

Voluntary Contributions

St Paul's operates both Building and Library Funds with deductible gift recipient status. Donations to these funds are tax deductible and contribute towards the development of learning spaces and library resources.

Other Charges

International Baccalaureate Diploma Exam

- \$195 per term - Exam Administration Fee

Private Bus Travel

- Silverdale Route: \$5.00/trip
- Kurrajong Route: \$7.00/trip
- Windsor Downs Route: \$6.50/trip
- Castle Hill Route: \$8.50/trip

Charges apply based on the number of trips booked on a per week basis at the commencement of each year or upon application. A trip represents travel for either a morning or afternoon route. No credits are provided for absences once booked. If you wish to cease using the service, a minimum of four weeks' notice is required.

Duke of Edinburgh

Combines Service and Adventure for Years 9 to 11

- Gold Duke of Edinburgh: \$170 Gold registration and an estimate of \$1,850 for the New Zealand walk
- Silver Duke of Edinburgh: Year 10 Camp Levy includes registration and walks
- Bronze Duke of Edinburgh: Year 9 Camp Levy includes registration and walks

Where students join the Silver or Bronze Duke of Edinburgh programmes outside of the School's Year 9 and Year 10 Camp programme, additional fees may become payable.

NSW Rural Fire Service Cadet Brigade

- \$125 per annum - Membership and contribution to training costs and equipment maintenance.

Co-curricular Charges

Co-curricular charges require registration or parent permission prior to the commencement of the activity. Fees are charged on the mid-term Fee Statement or may be payable upfront through an online payment portal.

Enrolment and ongoing participation in co-curricular activities is at the discretion of the school and may be refused if the tuition account is in arrears.
