

**ST PAUL'S GRAMMAR SCHOOL PENRITH LIMITED****International Student Programme  
Code of Conduct for Students**

Students coming to study at St Paul's Grammar School ("the School") agree to the following obligations as authorised by their parents:

**1. Laws of Australia and New South Wales**

The laws of Australia and the state of New South Wales must to be respected and obeyed at all times.

**2. Supervision**

Students must obey the rules of the School, which are stated in detail in the Student Handbook. Students must accept the supervision and discipline of the School and the host family. Students should keep their rooms tidy and help with small tasks as a member of the host family.

**3. Schooling**

The reason for coming to Australia is schooling. The students are required to attend all classes, participate fully in the school activities, and complete all out-of-class tasks, including private study. *It is not possible to do this and at the same time engage in business or employment.*

**4. Communications**

Students are not to use mobile phones while at school. All telephone calls and internet access (local within Australia, and overseas) are normally to be paid for by the student unless other arrangements are negotiated with the host family.

**5. Drugs**

The possession and/or use of illicit drugs is not permitted, as such activity is against the law. Students who break this rule will be returned home..

**6. Alcohol**

Possession or consumption of alcohol while at School or at a school activity is strictly forbidden. Alcohol may be consumed only by those who are 18 years of age or older. Consumption should always be in moderation.

**7. Smoking**

The School is a declared smoke-free area. Therefore, possession or consumption of tobacco while at School or at a school activity is strictly forbidden. Smoking is also prohibited in the home unless permission is given by the host family.

**8. Security**

Upon arrival at St Paul's Grammar School, the students' passports will be collected by the School and held in the school safe for security and safekeeping.

**9. Overseas Travel**

Students are advised that they may only return to visit their home country over the Summer vacation period (during the months of December and January). Any other overseas travel arrangements may only be undertaken with the prior written consent of the students' parents and the School Principal.

**10. Sexual activity**

Students are not to engage in sexual activity while they are students of the School. Students who breach this rule may be returned to their home country.

**11. Driving**

Students are forbidden to obtain a driver's licence or to drive or own a motorised vehicle in Australia without the prior written consent of the School Principal and of the host family. Students must undertake the St Paul's Driving program before they are allowed to drive a motor vehicle to school. Students should refer to the school Driving Policy for International Students.

**12. Domestic Travel**

Travel within Australia, other than going to and from the School, is to be undertaken only with the consent of the family, host families, and the School, and at the expense of the student unless otherwise negotiated with the host families.

**13. Paid Employment**

Study visas limit students' access to paid employment. Conditions of such visas must be strictly complied with. However, it is the strong recommendations of the school that students do not undertake paid employment.

**14. Liability for Damage**

The student is responsible for and liable for any damage he/she has caused to the School or to the home or property of the host families.

**15. Gambling**

Students are not to engage in any form of gambling while they are students of the School. Students who breach this rule may be returned to their home country.

**16. End of Study**

The student will return home within the terms specified in the visa approval.

We understand and accept the terms and conditions of this Code of Conduct. We also understand that breaching this Code of Conduct may result in the student being required to return to their home country.

圣保罗文法学校国际学生行为准则**

签署这张表后，入读澳大利亚圣保罗文法学校的海外学生既已同意接受以下责任：

**1. 澳大利亚法律：**

- 学生在任何时候都应尊重和遵守澳大利亚和新南威尔士州的法律。

**2. 接受监督：**

- 必须遵守圣保罗文法学校人手一册的学生手册上所列的学校校规；
- 学生必须接受学校和住宿家庭的监督和纪律约束；
- 学生应保持在住宿家庭中房间整洁干净，并帮助所住家庭完成轻微的家务；

**3. 学校教育：**

学生来澳大利亚的目的是接受教育，要求学生按时上学，参加学校所有的活动，并完成所有课内外功课（包括自学课程）。学生在圣保罗文法学校学习期间不可经营生意或受雇打工。

**4. 通讯联系：**

学生在校上课期间不准使用手机，学生所用的电话费(本地和国际电话)和网络费用都由学生本人支付，除非居住家庭同意承担。

**5. 毒品：**

学生不得拥有或使用毒品，拥有或使用毒品会触犯澳大利亚的法律。学生违反此规定将导致遣送回国。

**6. 酗酒：**

学校严格禁止学生在校或在学校组织的活动中携带酒或喝酒，年满十八岁以上在某些情况或场合时可适量饮酒。

**7. 吸烟：**

圣保罗文法学校是禁烟区，因此学生严格禁止在校内或学校活动中携带烟或吸烟；同样，在住宿家庭中不许抽烟，除非年满十八岁的学生得到家庭的同意。

8. **安全:**  
海外学生到达后, 为安全起见每个学生的护照将保管在学校的保险箱内。
9. **出国旅行:**  
学生只有在十二月至一月份间的暑假才允许回国, 其它任何出国旅游都必须先由学生家长书面提出, 经校长同意。
10. **色情活动:**  
作为圣保罗文法学校的学生, 不得参加任何色情活动, 若有违反将被立即开除, 并可能遣返回国。
11. **驾车:**  
不经住宿家庭和学校校长的书面同意, 圣保罗文法学校的学生在澳大利亚不得获取驾驶执照和拥有机动车辆。学生必须经过圣保罗文法学校驾车安全教育后方允许开车到学校。学生应参照并执行圣保罗文法学校海外学生驾车规定。
12. **国内旅行:**  
学生, 不包括上学放学, 在澳大利亚境内的旅行, 都必须得到住宿家庭和学校校长的同意, 且费用自负或与住宿家庭协商。
13. **有酬打工:**  
中学生限制打工是学生签证的条件规定, 学校要求学生不可有酬打工。
14. **损害物品应负的责任:**  
学生应对本人造成的学校或住宿家庭的财产损失负责。
15. **赌博:**  
学生在圣保罗文法学校学习期间不得参与任何形式的赌博, 学生如被发现赌博现象, 将受开除处罚并遣送回国。
16. **学习结束:**  
学生应在完成学业后, 在签证有效期内回国。

我们理解并愿意接受以上《圣保罗文法学校国际学生行为准则》所列的项目和要求, 我们也清楚如果违反以上规定的结果将导致学生本人被遣送回国。
