International Schedule of Fees and Charges

Effective from December 2025

Please note: All amounts included on this fee schedule are in Australian Dollars (\$AUD).

Application and Enrolment

Application Fee **\$1,000 per student**

The fee is not refundable and is inclusive of GST. The fee is payable upon receipt and processing of applications through to Interview and Offer Document and will be deducted from initial payments to the school before a Confirmation of Enrolment document can be issued.

Enrolment Deposit **\$10,000 per student**

The Enrolment Deposit is due and payable to the School before a Confirmation of Enrolment can be issued. The Enrolment Deposit will be forfeited (becomes non-refundable) in accordance with the School's International Student Programme Refund Policy, available upon request.

Non-Tuition Fees

All Non-Tuition Fees are payable in advance and in accordance with the terms and conditions of the International Student Enrolment Contract and CRICOS regulations.

Non-Tuition Fees may include:

- Resource purchases such as uniforms, textbooks, stationery
- Costs of accommodation arrangements including Placement Fee, Monitoring Fee, Homestay Fee and Guardianship Fee (if applicable)
- Travel expenses such as airport transfers, taxis and private buses used within Australia
- Optional activities relating to elective subjects or co-curricular programmes
- Cocurricular activity fees such as sport, other excursions and camps
- IB Examination Fee or HSC Examination Fee for both Year 11 and Year 12
- Medical Insurance
- Compulsory Activity and Resource Levies

Compulsory Activity and Resource Levies

The following levies are determined annually and will vary by year group based on activities included:

- Service Levy
- Camp Levy
- Technology Levy

Levies are intended to include the majority of compulsory charges that apply to all students in each year group for camps, excursions, incursions, swimming and athletics carnivals together with elective subject fees and various other services and resources provided by the school.

Medical Insurance

All International students are required to have Overseas Students Health Cover (OSHC). This can be arranged by the school, the parents or your Agent.

Accommodation Charges

International students will reside with a relative or one of our Homestay families during the school year. In all cases the Accommodation shall be reviewed and approved by the school because the school has welfare obligations under relevant legislation for overseas students. This applies to both students living in Homestay or living with an approved guardian/relative and fees will apply.

Accommodation and Homestay charges include:

Accommodation Placement Fee: \$250 one-off charge at initial placement

Accommodation Monitoring Fee: \$250 per term

Homestay Accommodation Fee: \$70 per night

The Accommodation Placement Fee and Accommodation Monitoring Fee is applicable to students either living in a Homestay residence or living with relatives. The Homestay Accommodation Fee rates stated above are effective from the first fortnight prior to the start of Term 1, 2025.

Other Charges

International Baccalaureate Diploma Exam

Higher School Certificate Charge

Approximately \$1,500 per student - subject to NSW Government Invoice

Government School Bus Service

Students who use the Government Bus service will be required to purchase an Opal Card.
