



2027 Christian Congregational Scholarship Information | Year 3 to Year 11

Christian Congregational Scholarships are offered in conjunction with the school's foundational values of Christian practice and purpose. Applicants are required to be in regular attendance at a Christian Church and to have a developing understanding of the Christian Faith. In addition, it is a requirement that one parent be actively involved in a Christian Church, including participation in worship and additional Church activities.

Scholarships vary in value and will cover part of a student's normal tuition fees at the school for the period determined by the Principal. Scholarships do not apply to levies or other expenses including excursions, camps, uniforms, textbooks, laptop, learning resources, or other cocurricular activities.

Christian Congregational Scholarships are available to only prospective students entering St Paul's in 2027.
