



Performing Arts Scholarship Application | Year 11

Performing Arts Scholarships are available to students who are entering Year 11 in 2026 or 2027. Students must demonstrate exceptional achievement or ability in the performing arts.

Applicants must demonstrate skill in music, dance, or drama, as well as a commitment to performance, in tandem with a committed pursuit of excellence in other academic studies. Students may demonstrate skill in more than one area of the performing arts.

Students are required to submit a portfolio that gives examples of their achievement and ability. Short-listed candidates will be invited to attend an audition and interview. Performing Arts Scholarships vary in value and duration, and are subject to ongoing satisfactory performance.

Scholarships vary in value and will cover part of a student's normal tuition fees at the school for the period determined by the Principal. Scholarships do not apply to levies or other expenses including excursions, camps, uniforms, textbooks, laptop, learning resources, or other cocurricular activities.

Please include copies of documentary evidence and the two most recent school reports in the portfolio. Please ensure the copies provided are **not** originals as the portfolio will not be returned.

Applicants will not be automatically auditioned. The panel will short-list successful applicants to be invited to an audition.

PERFORMING ARTS TUITION AND SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS

Performing Arts Scholarship recipients are not required to undertake private tuition at the school, although full facilities are available. However, it is expected that successful candidates will be receiving appropriate performing arts tuition either within or external to the school.

Students who receive a Performing Arts Scholarship are expected to contribute fully to the performance life of St Paul's. Performing Arts Scholarships recipients are encouraged to choose Music, Dance, or Drama (whichever is appropriate) as an elective subject in Year 11 to Year 12, and are expected to participate in ongoing activities such as school performance ensembles and/or groups.

Students will be expected to contribute to special occasion performances. Should the student decide to discontinue their performance pursuits at St Paul's for any reason, other than injury or a reason approved by the Principal, the continuation of the scholarship would be reviewed by the school.
